



Harmony Fellowship Dangerous Weather Policy

On rare occasions forecasts indicate that the weather in the Fort Worth area might be dangerous for people to get out in such as when we have ice storms. The Board of Harmony Fellowship is establishing this policy so that we err on the side of caution in calling off services or activities if our congregants would be in possible danger by trying to attend a scheduled event.

The Day preceding the Sunday Service or other church scheduled event, the Board President will:

1. Make calls to several members who live in outlying areas North, South, East, and West of the Harmony Fellowship location to check on weather conditions in the various areas.
2. If the conditions are determined to be unsafe, the scheduled event will be cancelled and the Communications staff will be notified to communicate by email, website, and set up a calling chain to those who do not have internet access.

Members are encouraged to watch their email, if they have it, and/or the web site at www.harmonyfellowshipoffortworth.org immediately before leaving their home when the weather reports sound potentially dangerous. The Board will try to make decisions regarding calling off an event as early as possible before the event is scheduled, but it may be as little as a few hours.

As stated above, the Board will make the best decision they can as early as possible, but will err on the side of caution to protect the safety of our congregants.
